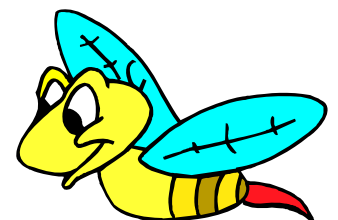

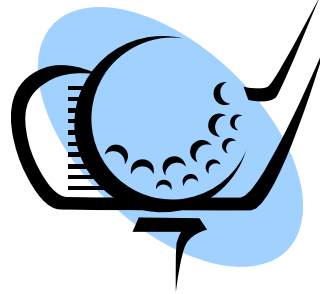

FIRST TEE-OFF TIME: 9:00 a.m.

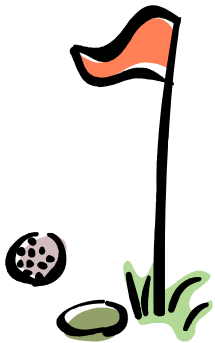
COSTS: Greens Fees will be \$16 for nine holes, which is a special rate for our tournament (regular rate is \$18).
