The effective date of this new tax is January 1st, 2015. The details are available on-line at http://www.fin.gov.on.ca/en/tax/eat/. The EAT is not an inheritance tax. It replaces probate fees which have been in existence for many decades. Members of the MC are looking into the implications and we plan to invite an expert to come to a general meeting to help us understand EAT and to recommend steps we may wish to take.
